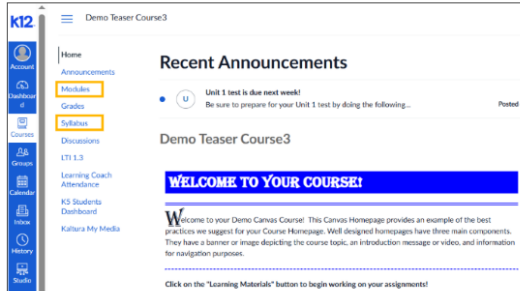
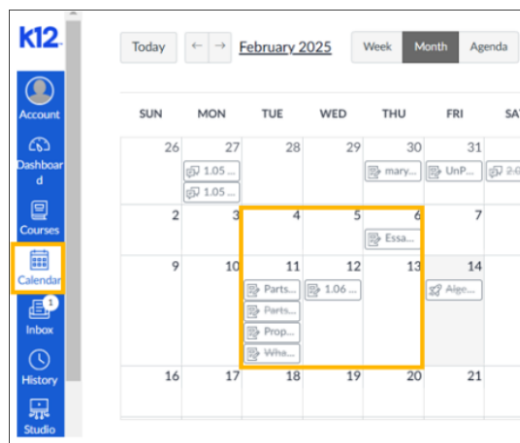


Identifying Teacher-Graded Assignments

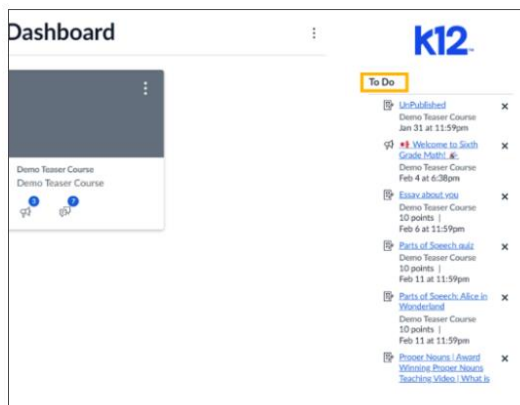
There are several ways to identify teacher-graded assignments.



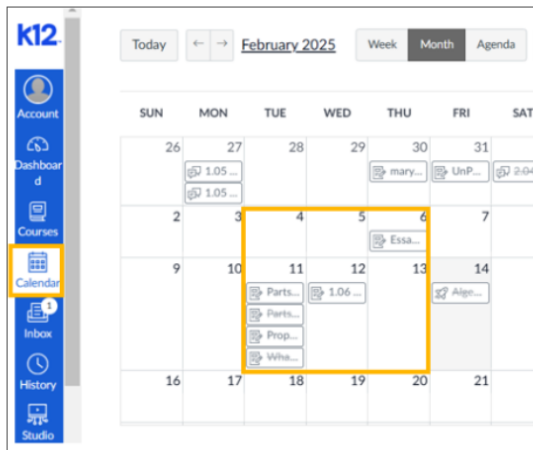
One way to find assignments is by selecting the Modules or Syllabus area of your course.



Another way to find your assignments is by navigating to the Calendar area of your course.

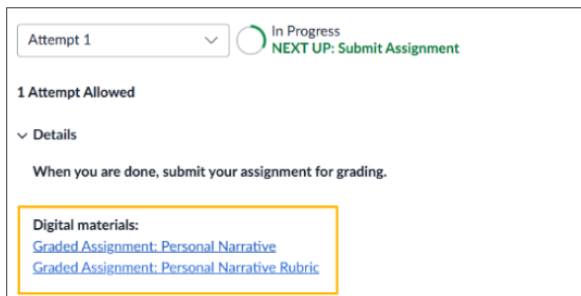


You can also locate these assignments in the To-Do area of your course.

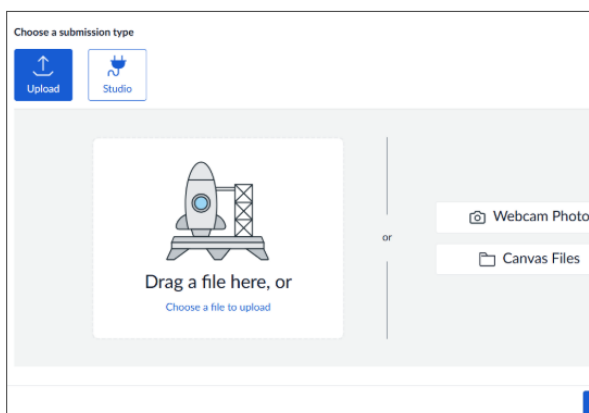
